

Gospel Acclamation SM 70c verses: Ordinary Time, Summer/Fall [Cycle A]



1.[20a] Jesus proclaimed the gospel of the kingdom | and cured every disease among the people.

- 2. [21a] You are Peter and upon this rock I will build my Church | and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it.
- 3. [22a] May the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ enlighten the eyes of our hearts | that we might see how great is the hope to which we are called.
- 4. [23a] God reconciled the world to himself in Christ | and entrusted to us the message of reconciliation.
- 5. [EHC] We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you, | because by your cross you have redeemed the world.
- 6. [25a] Open our hearts, O Lord, | to listen to the words of your Son.
- 7. [26a] My sheep listen to my voice, says the Lord; | I know them, and they follow me.
- 8. [27a] I have chosen you from the world, says the Lord, to go and bear fruit that will remain.
- 9. [28a] May the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ enlighten the eyes of our <u>hearts</u> | that we might see how great is the hope to which we are <u>called</u>.
