- 1.^{10th} A great prophet has risen in our midst. God has visited his people.
- 2.^{11th} God loved us and sent us his Son as expiation for our sins.
- 3.^{12th} My sheep hear my voice, says the Lord; I know them, and they follow me.
- 4.^{13th} Speak, Lord, your servant is listening; You have the words of everlasting life.
- 5.^{14th} Let the peace of Christ control your hearts; let the word of Christ dwell in you richly.
- 6.^{15th} Your words, Lord, are Spirit and life; you have the words of everlasting life.
- 7.^{16th} Blessed are they who have kept the word with a generous heart
and yield a harvest through perseverance.
- 8.^{17th} You have received a Spirit of adoption, through which we cry, Abba, Father.
- 9.^{18th} Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 10.^{19th} Stay awake and be ready! For you do not know on what day your Lord will come.
- 11.^{AV} Blessed are they who hear the word of God and observe it. (Assumption Vigil)
- 12.^{AD} Mary is taken up to heaven; a chorus of angels exults. (Assumption Day)
- 13.^{20th} My sheep hear my voice, says the Lord; I know them, and they follow me.
- 14.^{21st} I am the way, the truth and the life says the Lord;
no one comes to the Father except through me.
- 15.^{22nd} Take my yoke upon you says the Lord, and learn from me,
for I am meek and humble of heart.
- 16.^{23rd} Let your face shine on your servant; And teach me your laws.
- 17.^{24th} God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ
and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation.
- 18-19.^{25th, 26th} Though our Lord Jesus Christ was rich, he became poor,
so that by his poverty you might become rich.
- 20.^{27th} The word of the Lord remains for ever. This is the word that has been proclaimed to you.
- 21.^{28th} In all circumstances, give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus.
- 22.^{29th} The word of God is living and effective, discerning reflections and thoughts of the heart.
- 23.^{30th} God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ
and entrusting to us the message of salvation.
- 24.^{AS} Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened,
and I will give you rest, says the Lord. (All Saints)

- 25.^{31st} God so loved the world that he gave his only Son,
so that everyone who believes in him might have eternal life.
- 26.^{32nd} Jesus Christ is the firstborn of the dead; to him be glory and power, for ever and ever.
- 27.^{33rd} Stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand.
- 28.^{CK} Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!
