

- 3. My sheep hear my voice, says the Lord; I know them, and they follow me.
- 4. Speak, Lord, your servant is listening. You have the words of everlasting life.
- 5. Let the peace of Christ control your hearts; let the word of Christ dwell in you richly.
- 6. Your words, Lord, are Spirit and <u>life</u>; you have the words of everlasting <u>life</u>.
- 7. Blessed are they who have kept the word with a generous heart and yield a harvest through perse verance.
- 8. You have received a Spirit of a doption, through which we cry, Abba, Father.
- 9. Blessed are the poor in <u>spirit</u> for theirs is the kingdom of <u>heaven</u>.
- 10. Stay awake and be <u>ready!</u> For you do not know on what day your Lord will <u>come</u>.
- 11. Blessed are they who hear the word of God and ob serve it. (Assumption Vigil)
- 12. Mary is taken up to <u>heaven</u>; a chorus of angels ex <u>ults</u>. (Assumption Day)
- 13. My sheep hear my voice, says the Lord; I know them, and they follow me.
- 14. I am the way, the truth and the life says the Lord; no one comes to the Father except through me.
- 15. Take my yoke upon you says the Lord, and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart.
- 16. Let your face shine on your <u>servant</u>; And teach me your <u>laws</u>.
